

Island Crest Way Crosswalk Improvements

- This project installs a pedestrian signal at Island Park Elementary and flashing beacons at SE 62nd and SE 63rd Streets.
- Construction will resume the week of February 17 (mid-winter break), with crews trimming branches and installing conduit for Puget Sound Energy's new power service drops.
- During the week of April 14 (spring break), crews will install and wire the pedestrian signal, the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs), new light poles, and related equipment.
- To reduce traffic delays on Island Crest Way, construction is being scheduled during school breaks.





Traffic Signal Safety Improvements

- This project makes minor upgrades to four City traffic signals in Town Center.
- King County Transportation crews have updated signal timings and activated new 4-section left-turn signal heads in the Town Center at the SE 27th/77th Ave and SE 27th/78th Ave intersections.
- These upgrades enable protected left turns, improving traffic flow and efficiency at both intersections.
- Other work includes new pedestrian push buttons and enhanced signal heads.
- The project is now approximately 90% complete.





Thrift Shop Construction

- Construction at the Thrift Shop is scheduled!
- Starting February 3, contractors will begin mobilizing for the rebuild of the covered walkway and garage.
- The Thrift Shop will be closed from Feb 8 to 22 to allow contractors to complete all work that will affect donation and retail operations at the store.
- During this time, there will be no donation drop off and no shopping.
- We'll be pushing out extensive communications on this project to inform the community.





YFS Launches PARENT LAB

- On January 23, YFS is launching PARENT LAB, a new parentsupport program funded by the Best Start for Kids grant.
- PARENT LABS are in-person, interactive workshops that teach parenting skills and build on the content of the Parenting Mercer Island online tool. PARENT LABS are facilitated by YFS counselors and staff.
- Topics include: stress and anxiety; connecting and communicating with your child; guidance and discipline for skill building, everyday parenting challenges, and important conversations with your adolescent/teen. Each lab is age-focused and participants can attend all four sessions or choose topics of interest.
