Why Update the Comprehensive Plan?

- Adoption and periodic review of a comprehensive plan under the Growth Management Act (GMA).
- Since the last update, the WA Legislature has established several specific requirements for local comprehensive plans.
- Periodic update of the Comprehensive Plan's 20-year horizon (2024-2044).
- Address new GMA requirements, particularly for housing.
- Periodic review must be completed by December 31, 2024.







Economic Development Element

- Establishes strategies, projects, and programs to:
 - Retain existing businesses;
 - Attract new businesses;
 - Support the local workforce; and
 - Grow partnerships with other organizations to grow the local economy
- Outlines what the City will do over the next twenty years to support the economy.
- Includes policies to implement and track the element with a specific process.

Parks and Open Space Element

 New Element that adopts the Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PROS) Plan by reference.

Provides policy direction for the adoption of new zones:

- Phase 1 With Comp Plan Update: Open Space Zone
- Phase 2 Following Comp Plan Update: Parks Zone

Housing Element

- Establishes strategies, projects, and programs to:
 - Address statewide requirements for affordable housing;
 - Plan for adequate capacity to meet the City's 20-year housing needs; and
 - Incorporate requirements from other statewide legislation passed in recent years.
- Primarily focused on increasing the supply of affordable housing for households earning less than the area median income.
- Includes policies to implement and track the element with a specific process.

Agency Comments

- The City has received some comments on the 2024 Comprehensive Plan periodic update from state and regional agencies.
- The City continues to wait for comments from the Washington Department of Commerce.
- All agency comments are expected by the end of July.
- Staff will compile and review all agency comments received as well as present the Council with recommendations for amendments to respond on September 3, 2024.

Council Proposed Amendments

- **July 29** Introduction, Land Use Element and Housing Element
- August 5 Transportation Element, Utilities Element and Capital Facilities Element
- August 12 Economic Development Element, Parks and Recreation Element and Shoreline Master Program

Next Steps

July 17 – August 12, 2024 – City Council review and submittal of proposed amendments to the June 12, 2024 PC recommended draft.

September 3, 2024 – City Council deliberation on City Council proposed amendments as well as recommended amendments resulting from agency comments.

September 17, 2024 – (Tentative) First reading of an ordinance to adopt the 2024 Comprehensive Plan.

October 2024 – (Tentative) Second reading of an ordinance to adopt the 2024 Comprehensive Plan
