TIP Timeline

Draft Development

- Open public comment period on March 24
- 34 comments
- Develop preliminary project list

Council Review & Public Hearing (May 4)

- Hold public hearing
- Receive direction from Council

Final Draft Development

- Incorporate input from Council
- Receive & summarize 15 additional public comments
- 2 additional comments received after AB published

We are HERE

Council Adoption (June 1)

- End public comment period
- Close public hearing



TIP Preview (May 4)

City Council discussed and provided direction:

- 1. West Mercer Way Chip Seal and HMA Overlay.
- 2. Adding an ICW Corridor Safety Analysis.
- 3. North-South Bike Route on ICW.



Changes to Draft TIP

West Mercer Way Chip Seal [SP105]

- o Remove HMA overlay option for now.
- Survey the public to solicit feedback on use of HMA vs chip seal for roadway resurfacing.
- o Provide results to Council prior to proceeding with the chip seal project (scheduled in 2023). Gives Council time to decide how to proceed with the project.



Changes to Draft TIP

- Add a new project → Island Crest Way Corridor Safety Analysis
 - o ICW from 90th Ave. SE, south through SE 68th Street.
 - Proceed this year. Present results to Council in Q1 2022.
 - o Focus on many safety related items including:
 - Ped/bicycle facilities
 - Illumination
 - Visibility/sight lines
 - Crosswalks

- Roadway/intersection safety and capacity
- Parking

 Types of users (drivers, pedestrians, cyclists, school children, etc.)

- o \$75,000 in 2021 and \$25,000 in 2022. (estimate)
- Analysis will inform future planning of capital projects along ICW corridor, including North-South Bike Route project.



Changes to Draft TIP

- North-South Bike Route [SP119]
 - Shift the start of this project by one year from 2022 to 2023 to account for timing of ICW
 Corridor Safety Analysis.
 - o Analysis will inform the future scope of this project.

3. Appropriate \$100,000 from the Fund Balance in the Street Fund for the Island Crest Way Corridor Safety Analysis.
