## **SUMMARY**

The Mercer Island Arts Council (Arts Council) has collaborated with City staff since May 2024 to develop a 6-Year Workplan for the Art in Public Places Program (the Plan), a planning-level document that will guide internal decision-making for future public art projects. Details about the Arts Council's discussions to-date are available in the <u>Staff Report</u> from the September 16 special meeting.

At the October regular meeting, staff will seek feedback on updated public art goals, actions, and selection criteria (Exhibit 1) and will present a draft list of public art project opportunities (Exhibit 2). Input from the Arts Council will be used to refine the next draft of materials, which will be shared for discussion at the next special meeting on November 18.
