LBP Sports Court Renovations

4004 ICW Repairs and Improvements

- This project installed landscaping and pedestrian improvements in late 2023 on City-owned property at the corner of Island Crest Way and SE 40th Street.
- Staff noticed significant plant material die-off in Spring 2024. Soils tests confirmed the landscaping was intentionally vandalized with herbicides and a police report was filed.
- Last week, Kamins Construction removed the damaged landscaping and contaminated topsoil.
- Next week, crews will begin bringing in new, clean topsoil and new trees and shrubs. The irrigation system will be reinstalled.
- Work is weather dependent but should be completed by the end of December.





Sewer SCADA System Replacement


- This project replaces the equipment for the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system to provide reliable sewer system monitoring.
- Teams are nearing the 30% completion milestone, with SCADA upgrades successfully completed at sewer pump stations 12, 15, 16, 17, and 18.
- Valley Electric is working at the following stations over the next month:
 - Pump Station 19 (7651 W Mercer Way)
 - Pump Station 20 (8790 85th Ave SE)
 - Pump Station 21 (8002 Avalon Pl)
- The project will pause after December 20 and then resume in the new year.





Town Center Pedestrian Improvements

- Last week, contractor crews poured more concrete sidewalk along 80th Avenue. This is part of the larger pedestrian project happening along 80th Ave SE.
- Weather permitting, additional sidewalk grading and concrete work will occur along 80th Avenue in the coming weeks.
- Crews have also completed the replacement of eleven ADA ramps, along SE 27th Street and at the SE 28/78th Avenue intersection.
- Staff will conduct a walk through of the new ramps next week to identify any remaining punch list work.





Healthy Youth Initiative

- The YFS Healthy Youth Initiative team hosted a Youth Suicide Prevention for Adults webinar last Tuesday
- 25 attendees learned tools to identify signs and symptoms of suicide and how to intervene.

Family Movie Night


- Join us for a Family Holiday Party on December 13th to watch the classic

Argosy Christmas Ship


- Join us on Sunday, December 15 at 7:00pm at the Luther Burbank Park Swim Beach to welcome the Argosy Christmas Ship!
