

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE AND THE CITY OF MERCER ISLAND
FOR USE OF THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

THIS AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR USE OF THE CITY OF NEWCASTLE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS ("First Amendment"), dated September ___, 2026 is made and entered into by and between the City of Newcastle ("Newcastle") and the City of Mercer Island ("Mercer Island"), municipal corporations of the State of Washington ("City") (individual "Party" or collectively, "Parties") pursuant to and as authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act (Chapter 39.34 RCW).

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into an Interlocal Agreement for use of the City of Newcastle City Hall Council Chambers dated November 8, 2023 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to extend the term and change the term to month-to-month basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agreed as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 4 Term/Termination is hereby amended and restated as follows: **Term/Termination.** This Agreement shall commence on November 1, 2023 ~~and terminate on December 31, 2026.~~ Beginning January 1, 2027, this Agreement shall automatically continue on a month-to-month basis. Provided, however, that Newcastle or Mercer Island may terminate the Agreement upon giving one hundred eighty (180) days written notice to the other Party.

Section 2. All other provisions of the Agreement not specifically amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
