**Alternative 2 Notes**

- \* Maximized width of breakwater to provide better protection for non-powered watercraft dock
- \* Provides single point of access for all floating docks
- \* Non-powered watercraft main dock and finger docks can have different freeboards
- \* Maximizes use of existing overwater coverage
- \* Some functional improvements to plaza
- \* Provides peak-season ADA shoreline access at north beach
