Exhibit 1: *Fire Flower* Images

Fire Flower by Gizel Berman was originally installed at the former Farmers New World Life Insurance building (now Riot Games). It was severely damaged during an attempted theft in November 2020 and restored in 2022. The repair costs were partially covered by insurance claim WCIA 20-1365, and the sculpture has been stored off-site until it can be reinstalled in Town Center.

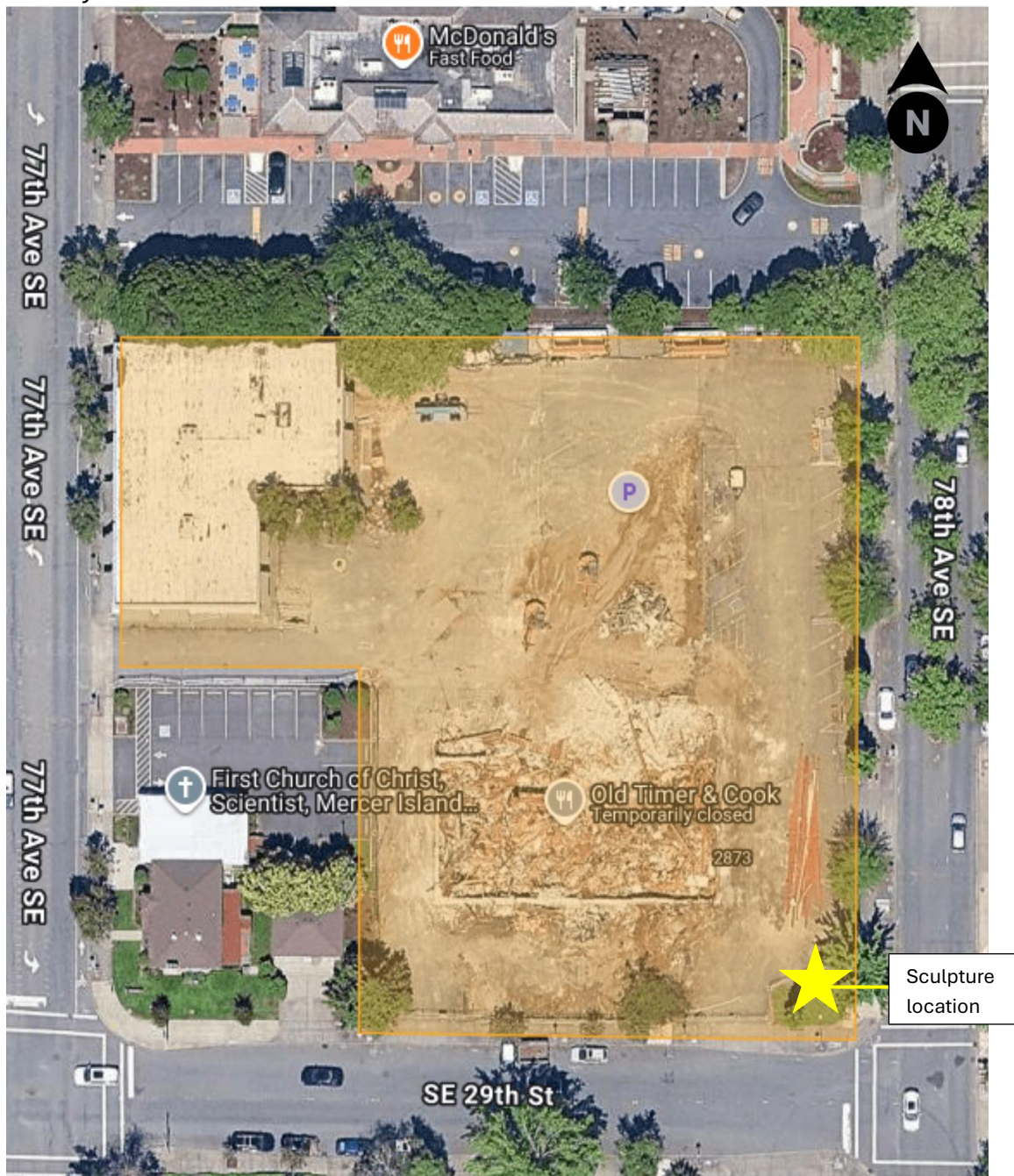
Image of Restored Sculpture



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At its [February 23, 2021, Special Meeting](#), the Arts Council endorsed staff's recommendation to re-site the sculpture in Town Center at the corner of SE 29th Street and 78th Avenue SE as part of the [Xing Hua mixed-use development](#). The sculpture will be returned to Town Center by the end of 2026.
