ORDINANCE NO. 24-21

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF MERCER ISLAND, WASHINGTON FOR THE YEARS 2025-2026 AND SETTING FORTH IN SUMMARY FORM THE BIENNIAL TOTALS OF ESTIMATED REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR EACH FUND.

WHEREAS, state law (specifically, chapter 35A.33 RCW) requires the City to adopt a biennial budget and provides procedures for the filing of an adopted budget, deliberations, public hearings, and final fixing of the budget; and,

WHEREAS, a preliminary budget for the 2025-2026 biennium has been prepared and filed with the City Clerk as required by law; and

WHEREAS, public hearings have been held for the purposes of fixing the final budget, and the City Council has deliberated and made adjustments and changes deemed necessary and proper;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCER ISLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 2025-2026 Budget Adoption

The final 2025-2026 Biennial Budget for the City of Mercer Island, covering the period from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2026, is hereby adopted. The final 2025-2026 Biennial Budget reflects the original preliminary 2025-2026 Biennial Budget, including 2025-2026 Budget Sections A through F, plus adjustments by the City Council and staff team during City Council Meeting budget workshops and public hearings to review the Biennial Budget.

Section 2. Summary of Revenues and Expenditures

The biennial totals of estimated revenues, including appropriated beginning fund balances, and expenditures for each separate fund are set forth in the table on the next page, and are hereby appropriated for the 2025-2026 biennium:

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect five days after passage and publication in the official newspaper of the City as required by law.
