

#### Purpose - Design Refinement Discussion

- 1. Do the concepts reflect the community input received to-date? If not, what's missing or needs further emphasis?
- 2. Are the proposed uses and amenities consistent with the intended character of each park? Are there additions, removals, or adjustments the Commission recommends?
- 3. Are there specific features from different concepts that should be combined in the preferred design for each park?
- 4. Do the shoreline restoration and ecological improvements align with the project's goals for sustainability and habitat enhancement?
- 5. Do the concepts support equitable access to amenities across all waterfront parks?
- 6. Does a single concept or combination of elements best represent the Commission's preferred direction for each site?
- 7. Do the concepts represent appropriate levels of investment relative to the Commission's expectations for the joint infrastructure plan?



## Preliminary Design Concepts



#### Design Concepts Overview

- Three concepts were developed for each park.
- Each concept generally reflects a different level of investment in features.
  - Option 1 = High investment
  - Option 3 = Low investment
- Individual elements are interchangeable between concepts.
- The designs aim for a balanced approach for amenities between the parks.



#### Clarke Beach - Design Consistencies

- 1. All concepts remove the existing concrete bulkheads and sheet pile swimming enclosure.
- 2. Each design reflects a shift toward a more passive, nature-oriented park use. Formal swimming amenities are not included (Groveland Beach and Luther Burbank Park being considered for enhanced swimming facilities).
- 3. All concepts replace the existing restrooms with a smaller, modern facility to better serve anticipated needs.








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


#### **CONCEPT DESIGN OPTION 1 - SHORELINE ENLARGEMENT**






#### **CONCEPT DESIGN OPTION 2 - OVERALL PLAN**






















#### Groveland Beach - Design Consistencies

- 1. All concepts remove the existing concrete bulkhead.
- 2. Each design proposes replacing the elevated pier with a new floating pier.
- 3. All concepts replace the existing restrooms with an upgraded facility.




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


#### **CONCEPT DESIGN OPTION 1 - SHORELINE ENLARGEMENT**






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




#### **CONCEPT DESIGN OPTION 3 - OVERALL PLAN**





# Community Engagement – Early Findings



### Early Engagement Overview

- Open October 3-November 3, 2025
- 104 total responses (as of 10/20)
- Promoted via:
  - Virtual Open House on Let's Talk
  - Posters in parks and at MICEC
  - MI Weekly and social media posts
  - Postcard mailer to park neighbors (1,000ft radius, 410 households)
  - Community partner cross-promotion (MISD, *Mercer Island Reporter*, etc.)
  - Tabling at community events


Scope the project with City Council based on site assessments and early community engagement.

#### Plan Development

Share draft design concepts for community feedback, and refine into preferred concepts for each park based on input. Present the preferred plan for City Council approval and prepare for future design

## Survey Demographics

- Current response rates
  - 50% for Groveland
  - o 21% for Clarke
  - o 29% for Both Parks
- 60% of respondents live in Area B (between SE 40<sup>th</sup> and SE 68<sup>th</sup>).
- 39% are ages 45-54; 0% under 20.
- 50% do not have children under age 18 living in their household.



### Preferences for Broader Site Features

- 63% of respondents value accessible paths to the waterfront and between amenities
- 69% support having a small watercraft launch point.
  - Only 40% said ADA-accessible launch is important.
- 52% find a rinse-off station outside the new restroom important.





## Upland Improvements


#### **Seating Amenities**

- 38% of responses are for a large group picnic area with multiple picnic tables (shown in Concept 1).
- 54% are for small areas with individual picnic tables (shown in Concept 3).
- 42% are for benches.

#### **BBQ** Amenities

- 27% of responses are for small BBQ stations for individual or family use.
- 10% are for a large group BBQ station.

### Preferences for Broader Site Features

#### **Volleyball Court**


- 45% prefer to keep the sand volleyball court (either in its current location or relocated in the park).
- 28% prefer that the sand volleyball court be removed.

### **Restroom Facility Amenities**


- 93% want an outdoor rinse-off station
- 42% want changing rooms
- 22% want small personal lockers
- 19% want an adult changing station

36% prefer Concept 2








### **Tree Canopy Boardwalk**

- 8% would prioritize before implementing other park improvements.
- 32% would prioritize after implementing other park improvements.
- 20% prefer not to include the tree canopy boardwalk or the elevated viewing deck



### **Elevated Viewing Deck**

- 6% would prioritize before implementing other park improvements.
- 29% would prioritize after implementing other park improvements.
- 20% prefer not to include the tree canopy boardwalk or the elevated viewing deck.




