



City of Mercer Island, Washington Proclamation Ending Local Emergency

WHEREAS, to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of Mercer Island, as well as continuity of government operations, the City issued Proclamation No. 365 declaring a local emergency related to the impacts of multiple water main breaks along East Mercer Way during the evening of August 5, 2025, and morning of August 6, 2025; and

WHEREAS, impacts of the Main Breaks on Mercer Island include water service outage and interruption, flood damage to public and private properties, and closure of a segment of East Mercer Way; and

WHEREAS, City Public Works crews, in coordination with the contractor, promptly repaired the damaged water mains, restored water service, and mitigated other impacts associated with the main breaks; and

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 365 is no longer necessary to preserve the public health, safety, and welfare of Mercer Island or for continuity of government operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AS FOLLOWS:

End of Local Emergency. The state of local emergency related to the aftermath of the August 5, 2025, and August 6, 2025, Main Breaks along East Mercer Way declared in Proclamation No. 365 has ended. Proclamation No. 365 is no longer necessary to preserve the public health, safety, and welfare of Mercer Island or for continuity of government operations, and it is, therefore, lifted.
