EMW Emergency Water Main Repair


- The southbound lane of East Mercer Way near the 7700 block has been closed since August 2025 due to multiple water main breaks.
- Over 220 feet of water main was replaced, and contractors are now completing the resurfacing of the roadway.
- The southbound lane of East Mercer Way is expected to be open to traffic later this week.
- This lane has been closed since early August.





Town Center Parking Facility

- The Town Center Parking Facility was temporarily closed so that the City's contractor could finish installing landscaping at the site.
- Crews have installed the plants, irrigation, and placed topsoil and mulch. Crews also installed the new bicycle lockers.
- Landscaping has now been completed and the lot reopened for use.
