

## Mercerdale Playground Update

- In mid-December, crews finished installing the new train play sculpture at Mercerdale Park and the rest of the playground structures will be installed this week.
- Next steps: Playground surfacing comes next! We need dry weather and minimum 45-degree low temperatures to install the resilient surfacing it may take several weeks to get a window.
- City staff are estimating completion in late February.
  - And planning a ribbon cutting on a date TBD.

  - Bike skills


- Theater and movie camps
