

Clise Park


- Right-of-way gravel edge
- Approx. 4 parking spots






Gallagher Hill Open Space


- Gravel pull-out, right-ofway with some park encroachment

Pioneer Park – SE quadrant


- Right-of-way parking areas
- Approx. 12 parking spots






SE 53rd St. Open Space

- Mix of mud and gravel along edge of right-of-way and park property







- Wayfinding sign






- Sign with park map and rules adjacent to donated bench



Trail Standards

- The City does not have master plans for most open spaces and will likely not develop them.
- Master Plans are unnecessary given the lack of development on open space properties. Pioneer Park is the exception due to its size and heavy use.
- Comprehensive trail standards for interior trails currently only exist in the Pioneer Park Master Plan.
- The Citywide Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities Plan will be updated soon for the years 2025-2030. The current plan (adopted in 2010) does not address interior trail standards but does cover other trails, stairs, etc.
- If the City desires to create trail standards for parks and open spaces, this is likely where they would live. The PRC/OSCT may wish to add this to the recommendations in the hand-off memo.



Next Steps



Next Steps

- PRC and OSCT approve the draft Open Space Zone and Hand-off Memo.
- Chairs of PRC and OSCT will present the recommendation to the Planning Commission at the meeting on May 8, 2024.
- Planning Commission will conduct the legislative review and present a recommendation to the City Council in Summer 2024.
- The City Council will review the recommendation in Fall 2024.
- Staff will return to the PRC later in 2024 with next steps on development of the Parks Zone.
