YFS Staff Connect at MIHS

- The Healthy Youth Initiative hosted a table at the MIHS Summer Kick-Off event last week.

Luther Burbank Sports Courts

- Thanks to cooperative weather, our contractor was able to complete the surfacing and striping work at the sports courts ahead of schedule.
- The courts are open for play and have been packed!
- The last piece of this project is to restore the mural *Summer in the Wetlands*, which is scheduled to occur the week of June 30.
- Note: With high court use, comes some issues. The Recreation Division is monitoring the courts and working on policies to address issues as they arise.

Town Center Parking Facility

- Construction activity at the former Tully's Coffee site and Sunset Highway continues with the opening anticipated in a few weeks.
- Landscaping crews continue installing the irrigation system and topsoil, and the electricians have been pulling wire for new lights.
- The team also painted the new lines, installed wheel stops and curbs, and placed signs in the parking areas.
- The final landscaping across the site will occur in September and October, during cooler weather to ensure the new plantings have the best chance of survival.

King County Sewerline Upgrade

- Work on the North Mercer Enatai Sewer Upgrade project continues. King County is upgrading four miles of sewer pipeline across north Mercer Island and south Bellevue. These pipes, installed in the 1970s, are aging and reaching capacity.
- Pavement restoration work north of I-90 along SE 22nd St, 78th Ave SE, and North Mercer Way will begin the week of June 30 and is expected to take about 2 weeks.
- Single-lane alternating traffic will be in place, and driveway access may be temporarily impacted.

MIPD Responds to Down Aircraft

- Earlier this month, the Marine Patrol Unit responded to a small aircraft crash in Lake Washington just off the Renton Municipal Airport runway.
- MIPD joined Renton Fire Department units to rescue the pilot and passenger, who were uninjured.
- The aircraft was then stabilized and removed from the water.
- Our Marine Patrol Unit trains regularly for emergency responses like this and we are proud of the rapid and effective coordination among all agencies involved.
