Background

- Ordinance No. 25C-11 will adopt changes to comply with state law pertaining to objective design standards and design review (House Bill 1293).
- On June 3, the Council provided direction to (1) dissolve the Design Commission and (2) transfer design review authority to the Hearing Examiner concurrent with Ord. No. 25C-11.
- Ordinance No. 25C-14 would amend Title 3 of the Mercer Island City Code (MICC) as directed.

Ordinance No. 25C-14

Ordinance No. 25C-14 would repeal the existing sections in Chapter 3.24 and adopt a new MICC 3.34.005:

A. The Hearing Examiner will serve as the Design Commission for all quasi-judicial functions assigned and delegated to the Design Commission in the Mercer Island City Code. [...]

B. All other functions and jurisdiction of the Design Commission that are not quasi-judicial are assigned and delegated to the code official.

C. The membership of the Design Commission is otherwise dissolved.
