- The City manages a public art collection of 60+ 2D and 3D works installed around the community.
- Staff work with the Mercer Island Arts Council to steward the collection.
- Many works have been acquired through private donations.
- Last accepted a public art donation in 2017

Donation of Raven

- Palladium print by Ron Reeder, long-time Island resident, scientist, and artist
- Presented to the City by MIVAL in 2019
- Approved by the Arts Council in 2021
- Currently installed at Municipal Court



Partnership with MIVAL

- MIVAL is an all volunteer-run organization that has existed on the Island since 1961.
- In addition to being a visual artist collective, MIVAL manages a gallery in Town Center and offers scholarships to MIHS students.
- The organization has collaborated with the City on a range of projects and events throughout its 50+ year existence.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, MIVAL's partnership was critical in the Recreation division's ability to offer community events and activities.
