This letter is to inform you that the above-referenced application for a City of Meridian Mobile Sales Unit License is hereby denied, pursuant to these provisions of Meridian City Code:

Meridian City Code section 3-4-2(A)(5)(d)(3)(E), which reads, in relevant part: "The City Clerk shall deny an application for a Mobile Sales Unit License where: Within the five (5) years preceding the date of submission of the application, the applicant has been convicted of, or has completed a sentence of incarceration for, any of the following crimes, or any probation or parole violation related to such conviction: Any crime involving, or related to, use of or possession of drugs or illicit substances.

This decision is made on the basis of the recommendation of the Meridian Police Department. You may appeal this decision by delivering a written appeal stating the reasons for such appeal to the Meridian City Clerk's Office, via U.S. Mail (or in person), by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 13, 2021. Upon receipt of such appeal, my office will schedule a public hearing on the appeal at a City Council meeting within thirty (30) days.
