 - Cherry Lane Library renovation/planned history room (exhibits/computers)
 - Searchable in library catalog
 - Programming/schools

WHEN: THE TIMELINE

- Early 2021 final agreement signed between agencies
- 2021 Assess and build infrastructure/seek grant opportunities
- 2022 Digitizing
- 2023 Cherry Lane renovation
- 2024 MLD 100-year anniversary, Cherry Lane reopening/history room open
