A RESOLUTION VACATING THE 10-FOOT IRRIGATION EASEMENT LOCATED ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY OF LOTS 4 AND 5, BLOCK 2 OF THE TREASURE VALLEY BUSINESS CENTER – PHASE 1 SUBDIVISION, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT “A”; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2024 the City Council of the City of Meridian held a hearing on the vacation of the 10-foot irrigation easement located along the west side of the property boundary of Lots 4 and 5, Block 2 of the Treasure Valley Business Center – Phase 1 Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, after such hearing, the City Council, by formal motion, did approve said described vacation; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERIDIAN CITY, IDAHO:

Section 1. That a 10-foot irrigation easement located along the west side of the property boundary of Lots 4 and 5, Block 2 of the Treasure Valley Business Center – Phase 1 Subdivision, as fully described in Exhibit “A,” is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
