What

The Meridian Arts Commission (MAC) is now accepting applications from organizations or individuals seeking funding for projects or education that will enhance the artistic atmosphere and musical environment in the Meridian Community.

MAC advises on arts/cultural policy and promotes public awareness and participation in the arts.

Through this Support process, the goal of the MAC is to grow the artistic opportunities for the City of Meridian, inspire people to take pride in this community, and provide reasons for our surrounding communities to bring people together to enjoy a variety of artistic offerings within Meridian.

Total! funding available is \$7,000 for all projects during the 2022-2023 fiscal year Support cycle, which ends on ______. The Commission may award full, partial or no funding to applicants. All Support funds shall be utilized during the fiscal year.

If chosen, 80% of award will be given upfront and the remaining 20% will be given after a final report has been provided to the Commission within 30 days from project completion.

How to Apply

Who: Individual Artists, Educators, and Non-profit organizations located in the Treasury Valley, and the Native nations that share this geography, who's project will take place within the Meridian City Limits.

What: Applicants must:

- 1. Be a professional performing artist/ensemble of high artistic excellence and merit.
- 2. Contract with a professional performing artist/ensemble of high artistic excellence and merit.
- 3. Offer an activity featuring the professional artist(s) in an accessible facility/space that includes reaching an audience with limited access to the arts.

When: Between _____, and September 1, 2023

How much: Support awards usually range from $\frac{1,000.00}{5} - \frac{3,000.00}{5}$. If selected, the award may be a full or partial award.

Examples of eligible applicants include:

- Individual Artist(s)
- Nonprofit, tax-exempt 501c3, U.S. organizations
- Nonprofit colleges and universities
- Federally recognized tribal governments
- Units of State or local government

Ineligible Applicants

- This opportunity is not open to organizations applying on a fiscal sponsorship basis.
- For-profit business or organizations
- Artist's agents

WHAT MAC SUPPORTS

MAC Support funds encourage artistic and cultural events & organizations, individual artists, community programs and educational opportunities benefiting the Meridian community. Support will be considered in the following categories of the performing arts - dance, music, opera, theatre and musical theatre, magic, illusion, mime, spoken word, puppetry, circus arts, and performance art.

Support awards usually range from \$ <u>1,000.00</u> - \$ <u>3,000.00</u>. If selected, the award may be a full or partial award.

- MAC does not approve funding requests for more than 50% of the project budget. Applicants will be required to demonstrate matching funds on a 1:1 basis for requested support.
- Eligible sources for the required match include salaries and wages, in-kind contributions, volunteer hours, earned revenues (donations, ticket sales, other grants), cash, or other grant awards.
- 80% of Support funds will be issued up front with the remaining 20% provided within 15 days of project completion and receipt/ review of Final Report.
- Project or fund usage must be completed by September 1, 2023.

Project Requirements

- Activities should build an appreciation for the artist or their creative discipline and provide additional opportunities for direct interaction between an audience and the artist(s) or art form.
- Activities may be in-person, socially distanced, and/or virtual.
- The activities must take place in an accessible facility or on an accessible online streaming platform.
- Examples of activities include performances; masterclasses/workshops; lectures/demonstrations/panel discussions; meet-and-greets; curriculum-based activities; discussions/talkbacks; etc.; a library or school hosting a virtual author talk and writing workshop.
- Examples of ineligible projects include Projects that are part of a benefit or fundraiser; Projects that are not arts focused (e.g., food festivals, fireworks displays, conference keynote speeches, etc.); Artist fellowships/scholarships.
