



Rose Circle Fence Project 2026

What is the Project?

Replacing the existing chain-link fence with a 5'-6' Precast Concrete Fence.

When will the Project Occur?

Fall of 2026. Anticipated start date is early November. Project completion by 12/31/2026.

Who is paying for the fence?

The City of Meridian and the Meridian Development Corporation are paying for the fence through a partnership agreement.

Will the new fence be installed on private property?

No. The new fence will be repositioned and located within the Ada County Highway District (ACHD) right-of-way.

Does all existing fencing need to be removed during this project?

No. Existing fences along West Franklin Road can remain in place. However, the chain-link fence along S. Meridian Road will need to be removed. Privately owned fencing can be removed at no cost to the property owner during this phase of the project.

Who will own the new fence?

The City of Meridian will own the new fence and have authority to occupy the ACHD right-of-way via License Agreement with ACHD.
