We are aware of this issue and the City has been working with all of their partners (Police Department, ACHD, ITD, Transportation Commission, etc) to address this issue over the last several months. This traffic control is not being done by the members of the Church, rather they have hired MAV Event Services to specifically handle this issue. They have a permit from ACHD to conduct traffic control and should be working with residents living off Tree Haven to come and go from their homes. If you stop and speak with them, they should let you through, however, I'm sure if you try to drive through them without discussion, it would be met with resistance. They are going to be there every Sunday in perpetuity, so please try and work with them. This would be a much bigger mess if no one was flagging.
