I took a call the other day from a gentleman who asked for a crosswalk on N. Black Cat Road north of W. Ustick Road for the pathway at Five Mile Creek. We would not install just a crosswalk due to the posted speed on Black Cat and the fact the ADT on this section of Black Cat exceeds 10,000 ADT – we would have to make it an enhanced crossing site

After discussing this with Rebecca Phillips in our Transportation Planner and Josh (my supervisor), they feel that this is a request that should come from the City and be prioritized by the City, as the pathway is a city facility.
