ACHD did install those 'No Parking' signs at the request of the HOA Board. We just installed the signs on Monday – you are quick!!!

I acknowledge that parking may be an issue, and the residents of the neighborhood may find that some of the new apartment dwellers are parking in front of their homes. We eliminated about 5 potential parking spaces, and I'll bet that there will be many more vehicles than that that will be parking on the street – whether it is because it is more convenient, or because the developer was not required to provide an adequate number of parking spaces.

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
