Again, sorry if this is a repeat message as I keep getting messages showing my email was rejected.

Mr. Mayor and Mark:

Thank you for the email. The additional stop signs and other treatments along Chateau are a proactive measure associated with the Ustick Rd closure. ACHD has begun placing additional treatments in neighborhoods impacted by major construction along routes where we believe there may be unintentional detouring. Extra stop signs are generally removed upon completion of our project. This is simply an added safety measure we put into place during construction trying to prevent your streets from becoming a cut-through route for those trying to avoid taking the signed detour.

As far as the signals, it sounds like my team member did not follow-up with you, for which I apologize. The concern you brought up back in June was a known issue. As a result, ACHD switched out the controller with a new controller to try and address the problem. From what I glean from your message, there may still be issues. As such, I will ask the team to take a second look.

Thanks for your input. I hope this answers your questions. If not, I am more than happy to have a further discussion.
