Brian,

My name is Lloyd Carnegie and I am the Maintenance Manager at ACHD. We are currently reviewing the plans for this year's Chip Seal program, and one topic that has come up is traffic control—specifically, the increasing challenges of managing traffic on more heavily traveled roadways.

One option we would like to explore is whether the City of Meridian Police Department might be interested in assisting ACHD Maintenance with traffic control by having one or two police units on site. In past instances where police units were present, even for short periods, we observed a significant improvement in driver behavior, including reduced speeds and greater compliance with signage and flaggers, which is ultimately our goal.

Would you be able to connect me with the appropriate contact at the Meridian Police Department so we could discuss this potential partnership further?
