III. DESCRIPTION

A. Background

ACHD will be widening W Franklin Road between McDermott Road and Black Cat Road to five lanes. They will be adding curb, gutter, storm drainage, and widening the intersection of McDermott Road and Franklin Road.

The City will be adding water main in Franklin Road and a dry sewer main in McDermott Road.

B. Proposed Project

This project includes the construction of water, sewer, and street light improvements. The water improvements will include extending a 12" main 2900 feet in Franklin Road, installing water services and fire hydrants. The sewer improvements will include constructing 500 feet of dry line 27" sewer main and 191 feet of 8" sewer main with manholes. 34 street lights will also be installed.

IV. **IMPACT**

A. Fiscal Impact:

The costs of the City of Meridian infrastructure improvements are estimated to be \$1,600,118.

Funding is currently planned in the FY27 budget for water and sewer extensions. Funding for street lights will need to be obtained through budget amendment in FY27.

VI. **TIME CONSTRAINTS**

ACHD plans to bid this project in early September 2026. City approval of this agreement is required for ACHD to include our infrastructure in the project bid and to include our utility improvements as part of their project.
