2. **Project Updates:** Chateau Park Public Art, Linder Road Median Public Art, Traffic Boxes  
**Chateau Park Public Art is in the engineering stage, permits will be next.**  
**Linder Road Public Art: Selected artist Stephanie Inman will be meeting with the Landscaping Architect next month to define landscaping a layout design.**  
**The 5 WASD student traffic boxes will be installed in the next week. The 3 professional artist boxes were approved by MAC, and artists are working with the fabricator. Committee discussed potentially acquiring Claire Remsberg's traffic box paintings to be displayed in City Hall. The committee was enthusiastic about the idea and Cassandra Schiffler says she will inquire into this possibility.**
3. **Discuss:** Art Party Mural Panel Locations and Installations

**Committee discussed the locations and installations of the mural panels from the Community Art Party. There was also a discussion about purchasing the artwork and compensating the artists for finalizing their pieces, doing the install, and UV coating. Staff recommendation is \$1,600 per piece (\$25 per square foot). Committee agreed this is a fair price, in line with other mural artworks and projects.**
