DEFERRED ADJUDICATION ORDER OF DISMISSAL
[TX. Code of Crim. Proc. Art. 42A]
FELONY

On the 3rd day of August, 2015, this case was called for trial, and the defendant entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to the Court for the offense of Injury Child/Elderly/Disable W/Int Bodily Inj. The Court found beyond a reasonable doubt that the evidence supported a finding of guilt. At the request of the defendant and under Article 42A of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, adjudication of guilt was deferred, and the defendant was placed on community supervision for a term of 10 Years, subject to the terms and conditions listed on the community supervision order.

The Court now finds as follows:

☒ That said sentence has expired.

☐ Defendant has satisfactorily served more than two years, and has not been involved in any criminal offenses during said community supervision term.

☐ Defendant has satisfactorily served one third of the assessed term, and has not been involved in any criminal offenses during said community supervision term.

☐ The defendant has been on INACTIVE supervision for one year, and has not been involved in any criminal offenses during this time.

☐ The defendant has died.

Except as provided by Section 12.42(g), Penal Code, a dismissal and discharge under this section may not be deemed a conviction for the purposes of disqualifications or disabilities imposed by law for conviction of an offense.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED this 4th day of Aug., 2025, that the defendant is hereby discharged from community supervision and the cause is dismissed.

The defendant is further informed that (s)he may be eligible to petition the court for an Order of Nondisclosure, Pursuant to Section 411.081, Texas Government Code. If eligible for an Order of Nondisclosure, the earliest date the defendant may be eligible to file the petition is on the fifth anniversary of this Order.
