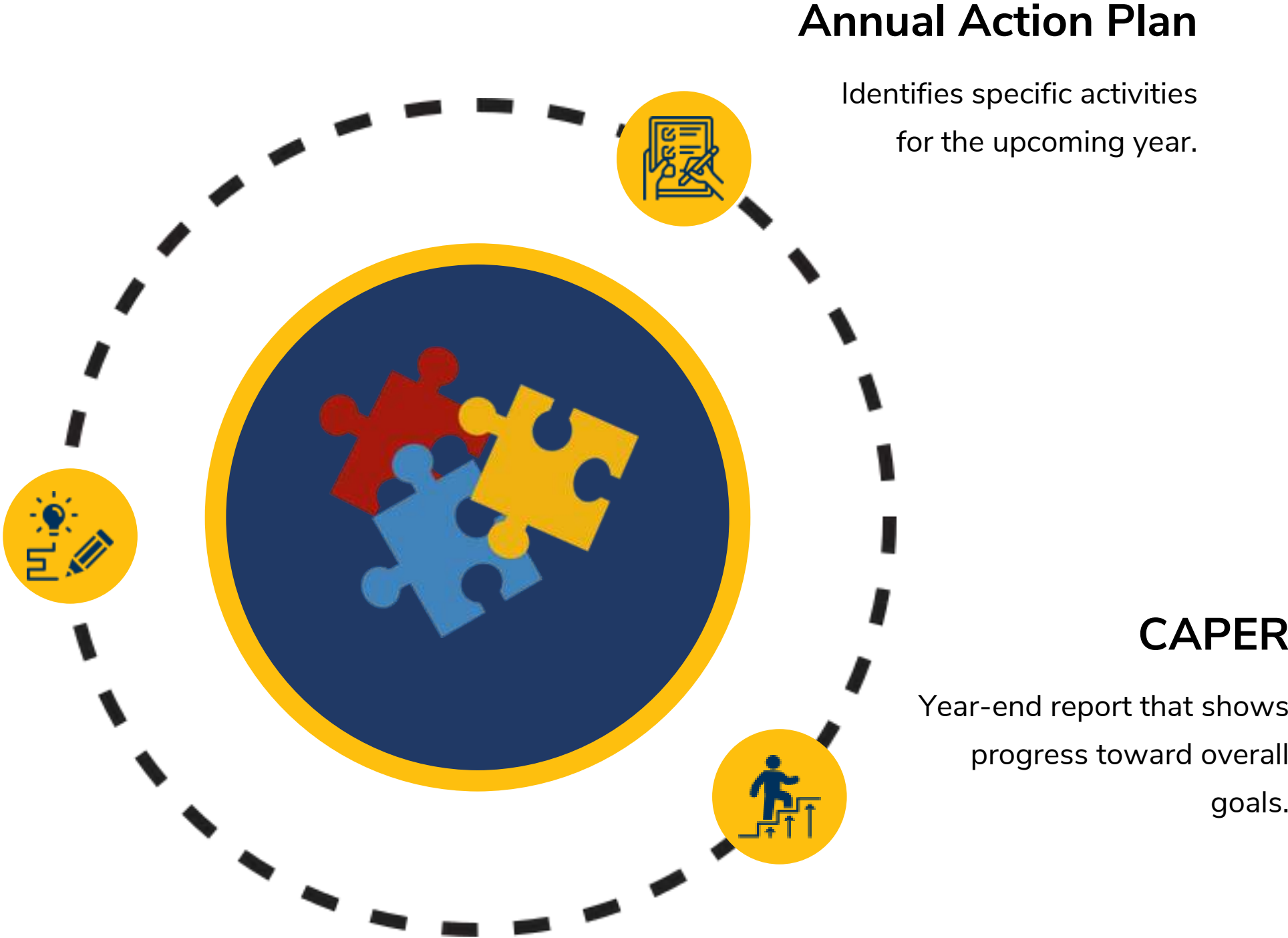
Overview of CDBG Program
