Dear Mr. Bower,

This letter is to inform you that the above-referenced application for a City of Meridian Temporary Use Permit is hereby **denied**, pursuant to Meridian City Code section 3-4-7(C), which reads, in relevant part:

The City Clerk shall deny an application for a temporary use permit where a permit is applied for on a parcel that already has or has had an approved temporary use permit issued for one hundred twenty (120) calendar days, whether such days are consecutive or not, per property, per calendar year.

The property at 305 W. Overland Rd. (Ada County Parcel #S1224110310) has already hosted a temporary sales unit for 120 days within this calendar year. For this reason, you may not operate a temporary sales unit at this address for the remainder of the year.

You may appeal this decision by delivering a written appeal stating the reasons for such appeal to the Meridian City Clerk's Office, via U.S. Mail, or in person to 33. E. Broadway Ave., Meridian, ID 83642 by 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2026. Upon receipt of such appeal, my office will schedule a public hearing on the appeal at a City Council meeting within thirty (30) days. The City Council's decision on such appeal shall be a final decision.
