
Legislative Summary Florida Shared-Use Nonmotorized Trail Network

- Promotes heritage tourism (Micanopy, Paynes Prairie, Bartram Trail)
- Authorizes DEP to establish a program to recognize
 Trail Towns (GVL, Lake Butler, Palatka)
- Extends SUN Trail to FL Wildlife corridor lands (previously disturbed lands only)
- Doubles annual funding to \$50 million from the State
 Transportation Trust Fund


Legislative Summary Florida Shared-Use Nonmotorized Trail Network

- Must be physically separate from Motor Vehicle traffic
- Authorizes State of FL to coordinate land acquisition
- □ Signed into law and fully funded July 1, 2023
- Requires <u>local support</u>, <u>local priority</u>, local maintenance

SUN Trail Network




SUN Trail Network - NE Region




Palatka to St. Augustine Trail

- Countywide bicycle pedestrian masterplan is in process
- Alison Moss is the project manager for the master plan
- Citizens need to get the GHT -> Micanopy spur relisted on the Alachua County bicycle pedestrian masterplan.

The Process - State


- State (DEP OG&T) looks to counties for priority trail recommendations
- Trails Designated as priority status by DEP get funded by FDOT
- State received 37 LOS for the GHT -> Micanopy connector
