ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3396

TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN AND APPROPRIATING \$2,567,500 FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MIDDLETOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Township of Middletown, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, authorizes for various capital improvements, including but not limited to, acquisition of a vaccon/vactor truck, roll off truck and containers, various improvements at the Department of Public Works building and North Middletown pump station improvements Phase III, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plan and specifications therefor on file in the Office of the Clerk for the Township of Middletown, to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The amount of \$2,567,500 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance and which amount was funded from the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$2,567,500.
- Section 3. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Township determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Middletown may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- <u>Section 4</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
- <u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.
