

**Resolution No. 22-  
Resolution Authorizing a Chapter 159 Additional  
Item of Funding in the 2022 Budget – “Child Passenger Safety Seat Program”**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of an item of appropriation for an equal amount, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown has received a \$19,250.00 grant from The State of New Jersey for the Child Passenger Safety grant and wishes to amend its 2022 budget to include this amount as revenue, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of Middletown Township, New Jersey hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the 2022 budget in the sum of \$19,250.00 which is now available as revenue from:

State of New Jersey  
“Child Passenger Safety Seat Program”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a sum of \$19,250.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated under the caption of:

General Appropriations  
Operations Excluded from the 3.5 % CAPS  
The State of New Jersey  
Child Passenger Safety Seat Program

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer forward a copy of this resolution to the Director of Local Government Services.
