RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY CONSISTING OF USED BODY WORN CAMERAS AND ACCESSORIES TO THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown (the "<u>Township</u>") is in possession of 40 used body worn cameras, which are no longer needed for public use as the Township has procured new devices; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(6), if the estimated fair value of surplus property does not exceed the applicable bid threshold in any one sale, the Township may dispose of the property without advertising for bids and to other government entities; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Hazlet ("<u>Hazlet</u>") would like to acquire the Township's used body worn cameras and associated accessories as set forth in **Exhibit A** for the sum of \$5,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that it hereby authorizes the sale of its used body worn cameras and accessories as set forth in **Exhibit A** to Hazlet for the sum of \$5,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the surplus property being sold shall be sold in "as is" condition without express or implied warranties from the Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Administrator and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the foregoing sale.
