RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 24-159 APPOINTING SECOND MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR FOR THE REMAINDER OF 2024

WHEREAS, the Township of Middletown's (the "**Township**")'s longstanding First Municipal Prosecutor John Lane, Esq. passed away prior to the completion of his term, therefore, leaving a vacancy that is being filled by the Township's Second Municipal Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:25-4 and § 7-33 of the Code of the Township there exists a need to appoint a qualified attorney as the Second Municipal Prosecutor for the Township; and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2024, pursuant to Resolution No. 24-159, the Township appointed Ian Goldman, Esq. to serve as the Township's Second Municipal Prosecutor for the remainder of 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to amend Resolution No. 24-159 to include Mr. Goldman's law firm, Levin Shea Pfeffer & Goldman, and Matthew Borriello, Esq. of the firm as part of the Second Municipal Prosecutor's appointment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2005-32, such salaried appointed positions are not subject to the Fair and Open Process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Middletown in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that Ian Goldman, Esq., Matthew Borriello, Esq. and the law firm of Levin Shea Pfeffer & Goldman are hereby appointed as the Second Municipal Prosecutor for the Township for the remainder of 2024 to be compensated pursuant to the Township's applicable salary ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of this appointment shall be published by the Township Clerk in the Township's official newspaper.
