CALL TO ORDER

1. REQUEST OF CITIZENS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

Committee member Scott stated that a constituent of his ward addressed that the yield sign on 5th and Pacific be changed to a stop sign. Public Works Director Samantha Malenovsky announced this would need to be discussed for recommendation at another scheduled meeting.

2. NEW BUSINESS

A. Review & Recommend Signage around schools and surrounding areas

Kelly Shoemaker, 1404 Butler Street, presented handouts of the streets and areas that she would like to see crosswalk signs up. She pointed out all the areas around each school zones that are currently missing the needed children/pedestrian crossing signs. There was a brief discussion on trying to get a volunteer program started to help with crossing guards for children in the school zones.

Committee Member Huber mentioned the need for the presence of the law enforcement in those areas to help with the citizens being cautious drivers in those needed areas. Captain Sloan via zoom explained that there is currently patrols in and around the school zones. The Police is currently understaffed, under funded at this time and there is not enough resources to allow to have an officer in each school zone for the high traffic times. Dispatch Director Lyne Anderson also explained that the Police Officers are usually inundated with high volume 911 calls during those peak times.

After all the discussion it was agreed that there is a need for crosswalk guards/volunteers and the pedestrian/children crossing signs along the school zones.

Motion made by Committee Member Thomason to recommend that the pedestrian/children crossing signs be put up in school zones starting with this year at the Pearl, Montana and 10th street areas and to make all of Pearl Street a 15mph speed zone from the tracks to Strevell, Seconded by Committee Member Simpson.

B. Review & Recommend Handicap Parking Signage on N 6th for One Health

Public Works Director Samantha Malenovsky gave an explanation that the One Health is requesting approval of 2 handicap signs along the side of the new building on 6th Street. Committee Member Huber stated that there is already painted handicap signage on that street and is inquiring as to who gave permission for that to happen. Director Malenovsky had no knowledge of One Health already marking the streets with the paint and stated it was not her department that did so. There was a brief discussion on the limited parking in the

downtown area and allowing these 2 handicap spaces would make the parking even more limited.

Motion made by Committee Member Scott to table subject, Seconded by Committee Member Huber.
