1. REQUEST OF CITIZENS AND PUBLIC COMMENT

Kelly Schumacher, 1404 Butler, stated that the cross walk at the intersection of Montana, 10th St, Pearl, and Atlantic is very dangerous. The crosswalk paint is faded and there are no children crossing signs. She also noted that the speed limit changes to 15 miles per hour only a half of a block past the intersection towards Lincoln School. She is requesting to move the 15 mile an hour speed limit sign to the other side of the intersection and asking for volunteers to be crossing guards at the schools.

Spencer Haynes, 2317 Mizpah, stated that the crosswalks going over the train tracks are non-compliant and it is hard for a person in a wheelchair to go over. He is asking that BNSF be addressed to get the problem fixed.

Brandon Janshen, SDI Architects, replied that it is a running total and this agreement only encompasses \$9,000 of that total. He noted that agreement 1 was for the structural engineer, number 2 was to approach the design phase, and number 3 is for bidding, negotiation, and construction.
