**A RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY OF MILLS, WYOMING TO
LEASE A FIRE ENGINE**

WHEREAS, the City of Mills has need to acquire a fire truck to replace a frontline structure engine; and

WHEREAS, Front Range Fire Apparatus has in stock a 2020 new, untitled, stock Pierce Enforcer Fire Engine suitable for use by the Mills Fire Department which is available for acquisition in a lease/purchase arrangement through Tax-Exempt Leasing Corp. and which is, further, currently purchased \$115,000.00 below market value; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in the acquisition of the fire engine due to, among other factors, the current price will not indefinitely remain; and

WHEREAS, entering into the lease/purchase arrangement may be facilitated by H-GAC, which the City is authorized to join

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the Mayor and such designees as he may choose to assist him including the Fire Chief are authorized to enter into the lease/purchase arrangement for the acquisition of a 2020 Front Range Fire Apparatus.
