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

Amandalynn Proposal Narative:

Montague Pedestrian Overcrossing Mural

My favorite part of creating mural work is that it is Art for Everyone. Murals are their own gallery display that are accessible to anyone who sees them. The sense of community and connection that I have witnessed behind murals and public art in general has been the core root of why I have chosen a lifelong career as a muralist. I enjoy creating bright beautiful imagery that celebrates the nature of the area in which I am creating. I find that even amongst industry and technology, we all need a little break and reminder of the beauty of our natural surroundings. I also find that nature is a universal connector, as it is recognized and celebrated by all ages, ethnicities, and genders. When starting a new project, I very much enjoy connecting with the communities in which I create. I feel it is important to do historical and environmental related research about the local region in advance to designing for each project. In this specific project, I will gather inspirational imagery through researching local wildlife, flowers, plants, and insects. I also enjoy using a color palette that compliments the surrounding area, while also enhancing the setting with a burst of color. Therefore, the piece I create will sit well in juxtaposition to the previously installed rainbow architectural enhancement. With bold colors and line work, the piece will be dynamic in both day and night, and it will include some subtle lighting effects. I tend to stay away from color changing and florescent colored paints, as they do not age well and tend to fade quickly. By strategically placing certain winged creatures and different elements, my piece will create an instant attraction for people to capture fun selfies and photo moments. As I mentioned, I truly believe that art should be for everyone, and I look forward to creating a piece that connects with the growth and enhancement of Milpitas.

Proposed Dimensions: Cover the entire surface area available for paint. I enjoy wrapping around walls and stairwells so that the artwork can be viewed from several angles.

Proposed Materials: Acrylic Nova Color Mural paint, sealed with Modern Masters Satin Clear Coat. If necessary, I will also apply a Kilz Primer undercoat before painting. **Muralist:** Amandalynn

Installation: Depending on accessibility, use of heavy equipment such as an articulating boom, reach lift or scissor lift would be ideal. If that is not possible then scaffold and ladders will be used to access the surface. I am a licensed heavy equipment operator **Artwork Lifespan:** 10 years or longer with minimal maintenance, dependent on vandalism. There is very little annual maintenance unless the artwork is defaced or damaged in some way. If this occurs, I will repair areas at no cost for the first 2 years, a maximum of twice a year. Any further maintenance, I will bill at \$100 per hour plus materials.

Public Interaction: Definitely encouraged. The Public usually naturally wants to take photos in front of my work and I will strategically place images such as winged creatures and flowers so as to make for fun photo opportunities.

Proposed Materials: -Nova Color Acrylic Paint -Modern Masters Clear Coat -Kilz Direct to Metal Primer -Lighting effects for evening viewing

Amandalynn Proposal Timeline and Budget:

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Timeline:

- One site visit for measurements, surface and accessibility investigation, etc (1 day)
- Detailed design layout based on exact area to be covered (3 days)
- Design approval, materials purchasing, etc (2 days)
- Surface preparation (2 days)
- Painting Installation (7 days)
- Final clear coat and clean up (2 days)
 Total project = 17 days (design work, site visit, and approvals will all happen in advance to painting)

Budget:

- Artist Fee: \$6000
- Electrical Designer Fee and Installation Cost: \$2500
- Materials and Supplies: \$2500
- Equipment Rental: \$2000
- Interpretive Plaque: \$0 (will be hand painted on the wall and included in artist fee price)
- Administration Fees: \$500
- Travel Fees: \$1500 (Accommodations for onsite work 7-10 days)
 Total project cost = \$15,000 (I will provide all rendering, design layouts, etc, so there will be no extra fee for those services beyond the artist fee)
