The beauty of a city is highly influenced by the beauty of its buildings.

Along Montague Expressway, I find that the colors of the new buildings run the gamut from dreary / garish to attractive / cheerful. We should ask ourselves whether the proposed color scheme for a project is one that we would be happy to come home to.

In my view, the planned color scheme for this project is unattractive, especially the "Dried Thyme" dull green.

I recommend colors that are cheerful, but not garish---light pastel yellows, beiges, blues, and pinks, for example. I'm not fond of the "Needlepoint Navy" either, but maybe an alternating combination of a medium blue and a light pastel blue would provide visual interest and pleasing contrast.
