**AGENDA ITEM:** Consideration of a Blanket Right of Way Acquisition Approval for the Cox

Road at Kina Road Roundabout Project

#### **SUMMARY:**

Cox Road at King Road is a TSPLOST II project designed to improve operations and safety at the intersection by constructing a single-lane roundabout. The current intersection is an all-way stop-controlled intersection. It is a joint project with the City of Roswell due to its location impacting parcels in both jurisdictions.

There were 13 crashes at this intersection over a five year period (2017 – 2021). The intersection level of service is D (average 28.9 seconds of delay per vehicle) in the AM Peak and D (average 34.9 seconds of delay per vehicle) in the PM Peak. Without improvements, the delay at this intersection would continue to worsen.

Consideration of this agenda item is the final step for pre-acquisition standard operating procedures of the adopted policy. All parcels on this project have been appraised to determine Fair Market Value (FMV) for the acquisitions. Public Works staff applied an administrative negotiation factor allowed by the policy to all parcel FMVs, added them together, and are presenting this Blanket Right of Way Approval. This agenda item serves as the final review of the project location and design. This agenda item also authorizes staff and the city attorney's office to close parcels that do not exceed FMV + administrative negotiation value.

The approval of this item confirms the acquisition plan and budget for the project. Any justified counteroffer by a parcel owner that is above FMV + administrative negotiation value that make up this budget will be discussed in Executive Session.

Parcel 1 is located in the City of Roswell and will be acquired by Roswell per the terms of the approved Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA)

### **FUNDING AND FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

Based on Fair Market Value and negotiating limits, staff is proposing a right of way budget of \$102,100.00 for the purchase of land needed for the project. Once this budget is approved, the acquisition team will be able to continue making progress to finish the right of way acquisition and close parcels according to the adopted process.
