AGENDA ITEM: Approval of a Modification to the Blanket Right of Way Acquisition Approval

for the Bethany Road at Providence Road Roundabout Project

Executive Summary:

Bethany Road at Providence Road is a 2016 Tier 2 TSPLOST project designed to improve operations and safety at the intersection by constructing a single-lane roundabout. The current intersection is an all-way stop-controlled intersection. There have been 26 total crashes recorded over a five-year period with half of them being angle crashes. The intersection level of service is F (average 74.8 seconds of delay per vehicle) in the AM Peak and D (average 25.1 seconds of delay per vehicle) in the PM Peak. To handle expected future traffic volumes 10+ years from now, right of way is being acquired for a second approach lane on southbound Providence for Milton to consider expanding at a future date. This roundabout also includes speed tables on the western and southern legs as traffic calming measures to reinforce slower speeds.

On November 20, 2023, Mayor and Council approved the blanket right of way acquisition budget for the project of \$299,200 representing the sum of Fair Market Value offers for all parcels plus negotiation limits. Since that time, additional utility coordination has required impacts to 3 additional parcels. In addition, the right of way acquisition has updated FMV offers on several parcels to reflect increased areas and updated land costs. The revised total is \$411,500.

This agenda item authorizes staff and the city attorney's office to close parcels that do not exceed FMV + administrative negotiation value. The approval of this item confirms the acquisition plan and budget for the project. Any justified counteroffer by a parcel owner that is above FMV + administrative negotiation value that make up this budget will be discussed in Executive Session.

Funding and Fiscal Impact:

Based on Fair Market Value and prior guidance on negotiating limits, staff is proposing a right of way budget of \$411,500.00 for the purchase of land needed for the project. Once this budget is approved, the acquisition team will be able to continue making progress to finish the right of way acquisition and close parcels according to the adopted process.




