#### 1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

# 5. CONSIDERATION OF TEXT AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY OF MILTON ZONING ORDINANCE

A. RZ24-01: Text Amendment to the Unified Development Code for the City of Milton, Georgia to prohibit the scale of consumable hemp products and/or unregulated marijuana substitutes.

A motion was made by Commissioner Nolte and seconded by Commissioner Edwards to recommend Approval Conditional of RZ24-01 with the following comments/recommendations:

- 1. Include the term "unpackaged" with "prepackaged" in section "M" (Definition of Retail Consumable Hemp Product.
- 2. Correct the spelling of "plant" in section "M" (Definition of Retail Consumable Hemp Products".
- 3. Correct the indents of the new definitions within the Use Tables.
- 4. Address possible future change to law regarding exceeding the legal limit of .3 percent

The motion passed 6-0.
