

ORDINANCE 29-2024

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL CANINE UNIT POLICY AND INCLUDING THE POLICY IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT GENERAL MANUAL (POLICIES AND PROCEDURES)

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park desires to adopt an official Canine Unit Policy and to incorporate said policy into the Police Department General Manual; and

WHEREAS, the existing General Manual does not reflect the current practices, policies and procedures followed by the Police Department for a Canine Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor has reviewed and approved the draft Canine Unit Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

- Section 1.** The Village of Minerva Park hereby adopts the attached Canine Unit Policy, labeled as Exhibit A
- Section 2.** The attached Exhibit A is hereby incorporated and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set out herein.
- Section 3.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date permitted by law.
- Section 4.** That it is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code
