RE: **October 2024 Chief's Report**

Madame Mayor and Members of Council,

On October 26th, 2024 the police department participated in the Drug Enforcement Agency's National Drug Take Back Day. This is a collaboration of more than 4000 police agencies from across the country to remove unused and unwanted prescription medications from homes. This year, we collected over 12 pounds of prescription medications (pills only – no liquids) so it may be properly and safely disposed.

Beggar's Night 2024 was well attended despite the periodic precipitation. Only one incident reported of a bicycle stolen from the MI sub-division which officers returned to the victim a short time later.

There is nothing else to report at this time.
