




What could a skills zone look like?

Where do we put a skills zone?



Option 1

Roughly .3ac

Pros: Good use of existing space,

Cons: Relatively small area, shed needs to move, tree relocation

Option 2

Roughly .4ac

Pros: Larger area, topography for fun

features

Cons: Drainage?, taking on additional property, proximity to landscape yards



How can we get this done?

- Utilize VVMTA's skills and experience in building bike parks to maximize efficiency
- Minimize labor costs by utilizing VVMTA's volunteer base and potential for donated materials
- Utilize Town of Minturn/VVMTA equipment to save significant costs on machinery
- Potential for new sponsorship opportunities for additional revenue towards construction










Skills zone costs

- Using recent data acquired from the Eagle Bike Park build, VVMTA believes a skills area can be completed at the Minturn Bike Park for an estimated \$39,350
- This cost includes major items such as grading/site prep, features, labor, and additional shade structure

Dirt jump costs



For a total cost of \$24,970 the Minturn Bike Park would receive...

 A team of Jump Doctors skilled diggers and builders on-site for one week in the spring time performing updates and modifications
