Minturn Education Fund – Board of Directors

Thank you for expressing an interest to serve on the Town of Minturn’s Scholarship Board (the Minturn Education Fund Board of Directors).

The board meets annually on the second Tuesday of January each year and additionally as needed. The board also meets for scholarship applicant interviews in the spring of each year (application deadlines are typically on or around April 1st). Meetings may be held in person or virtually or a combination of the two.

To qualify as a director of this board, each applicant must review and agree to adhere to the Bylaws and any addendums, as well as any other policies and procedures established by the board. Directors must be natural persons, eighteen years of age or older. At least one and no more than two voting directors will contemporaneously serve as member(s) of the Council for the Town of Minturn (respectively, the “Council” and the “Town”) or as employees or other agents of the Town. The directors who are not council members, employees or agents of the Town must be independent members of the Town community who are qualified to manage the business of the Nonprofit, competently, and in a fair and impartial manner.

To be ensured of appropriate consideration, please complete the following information. You may also include a letter of interest, or use additional pages / attachments as needed. Applicants will be required to appear before Town Council for an interview.
