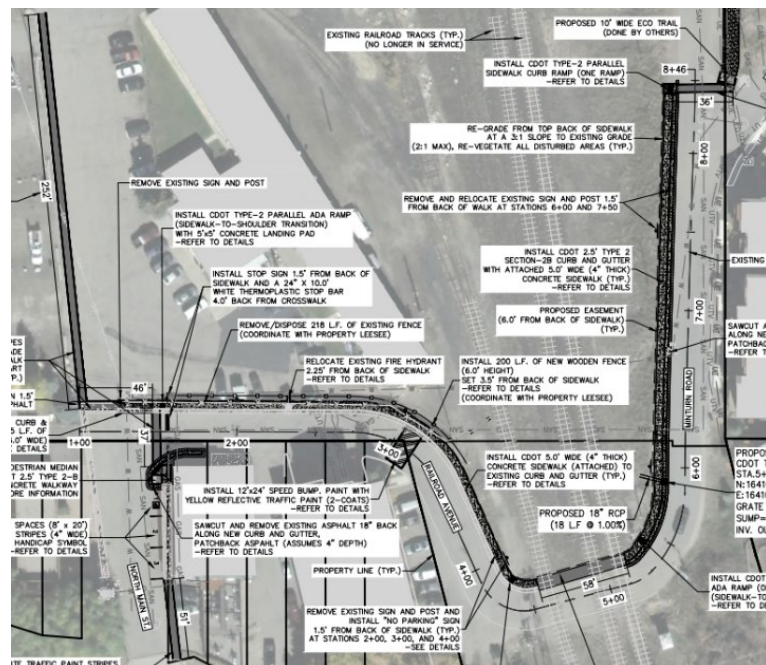
The project site includes pedestrian improvement along North Main Street, Railroad Avenue and Minturn Road. An image from the plan was inserted below.

VALUE ENGINEERING**

WHEREAS, the Town is in receipt of a sole bid for the North Main Street Pedestrian Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the bid amount of \$423,134 was the total for all items; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Budget included Revitalizing Main Street grant (#411037494 expiration 11/30/25) for \$226,800 and \$25,200 Town match totaling \$252,000; and

WHEREAS, North Minturn provided \$80,000 that would require a budget supplement; and

WHEREAS, \$332,000 is identified as total funds for the North Main Street Pedestrian Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires that Contractor perform North Main Street Pedestrian Improvement described in Exhibit A with value engineering decreased per Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to set forth certain understandings regarding the award and establish approval for a contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MINTURN, COLORADO:

1. The Minturn Town Council hereby award the North Main Street Pedestrian Improvement Project to 360 Civil Inc.
2. A contract will be provided to 360 Civil Inc. based on Exhibit B per agreed value engineering.

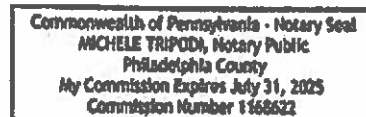
